

Off Licence

Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



007/OFF/46/2017

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Macka & Company Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **141 Queen Street, Northcote Point, Auckland 0627**, and known as **POINT WINES**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) **Alcohol may be sold on the premises only on the following days and during the following hours:**
Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 9.00pm
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons, at each entry and adjacent to every point of sale.
- (e) The whole of the premises is designated as a **Supervised area**.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

This licence expires at the close of 12 October 2020 unless renewed.

DECISION

Introduction

[1] The above named licensee has applied for the renewal of the **off**-licence in respect of premises situated at the address given above. The general nature of the business to be undertaken for the premises is a Bottle Store. The applicant seeks renewal on the existing conditions and days of the present licence

[2] A report on the application was received from an Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health and the Police.

[3] The Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health and the Police do not oppose the application.

[4] The application was duly advertised and did not attract any public objection.

Committee's Decision and Reasons

[5] I am satisfied as to the matters which I must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and I am satisfied that the application meets the purpose and object of Act. Accordingly, I renew the applicant's **off**-licence upon the conditions, days and hours set out below.

[6] I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.

Conditions

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day

- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 9.00pm
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premise
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
- (e) The whole of the premises is designated as a supervised area
